Become a Credentialed ENERGY STAR® HVAC Contractor

To be eligible to design and install HVAC equipment for Energy Star Certified homes, *HVAC contractors are now required to be credentialed through an EPA recognized third party organization.*

Home Chek will be providing this training throughout the State of Indiana in partnership with the Alliance For Environmental Sustainability and the EPA recognized H-QUITO organization, Advanced Energy Corporation.

The program will include training on the QAP program and the technical aspects of HVAC needed to perform quality design, install and start up functions on ENERGY STAR and other High performance homes.

This credential establishes contractors as leaders in the industry ready to perform new construction and remodeling work in other high performance homes such as LEED For Homes, Passive House, DOE Builder Challenge, NAHB Green Building, and Indiana Green Star.

Implementation of the best practices highlighted in this workshop provides contractors the knowledge to maximize the nationally accepted HERS Index standard (equal to miles per gallon rating) on every home and for every client in both new and existing homes. The workshop also provides an enhanced level of confidence in working with architects, builders, remodelers and homeowner's who demand the use of best practices and expectations of achieving the highest levels of comfort, safety, energy efficiency and overall performance.
